

## Kindergarten Students:

### *English/Language Arts (ELA)*

- Recognizes and writes first name
- Saying the ABC's and letter recognition
- Tell and retell familiar stories
- Hold a book upright and turn the pages

### *Math*

- Know colors and common shapes
- Count 0-10
- Counting by 5's

### *Other Items*

- Wash their hands
- Know how to snap, button, zip and buckle clothing and tie their shoes
- Follow two-step directions
- Sit and listen to a story

## First Grade Students:

In addition to all kindergarten suggestions:

### *English/Language Arts (ELA)*

- Write first and last name correctly
- Letter/sound recognition
- Know kindergarten sight words
- Tell and retell familiar stories with beginning, middle, and end events

### *Math*

- Count, recognize, write, and name numbers 0-20
- Counting by 2's 5's, and 10's

### *Other Items*

- Wash their hands
- Know how to snap, button, zip and buckle clothing and tie their shoes
- Follow two-step directions
- Independently pack and unpack backpack
- Know birthdate

## Second Grade Students:

In addition to all kindergarten and first grade suggestions:

### *English/Language Arts (ELA)*

- Write a complete sentence using capital letter and punctuation
- Read both fiction and non-fiction books
- Summarize books read
- Write first and last name correctly
- Know kindergarten and first grade sight words

### *Math*

- Practice basic +/- facts to 20
- Counting by 2's 5's, and 10's
- Know place value of ones and tens

### *Technology*

- practice logging in with username and password
- practice using a mouse and restarting computer

## Third Grade Students:

In addition to all K-2 grade suggestions:

- Read- both fiction and non-fiction books
- Practice Multiplication Facts- addition/subtraction and begin to learn basic multiplication
- Creative Writing
- i-Ready Reading and Math
- Reflex Math
- Typing Club

## Fourth Grade Students:

In addition to all K-3 grade suggestions:

- Read 20 minutes every night and discuss/write about what was read
- Multiplication fluency facts 0-12
- Addition/subtraction (no fingers!)
- Creative Writing
- i-Ready Reading and Math
- Reflex Math
- Typing Club

## Fifth Grade Students:

In addition to all K-4 grade suggestions:

- Read 20 minutes every night and discuss/write about what was read
- Multiplication and division fluency facts 0-12
- Addition/subtraction (no fingers!)
- Creative Writing
- i-Ready Reading and Math
- Reflex Math
- Typing Club
